Anna is a 79-year-old homebound woman with multiple impairments. While she receives chore services and in-home medical care, Anna has no real social outlets. Anna came to the HomeShare program as a way to help alleviate some of her social isolation and to increase her monthly income.

Rebecca is a 24-year-old woman and 2007 University of Michigan graduate. As a result of the economy she has not been able to obtain a job in her desired field and has been working various part-time jobs to stay afloat in the meantime. Due to her part-time employment status, she only makes \$900/month. Rebecca came to HomeShare as a means of finding affordable housing.

Anna and Rebecca were introduced and became fast friends. Anna provides Rebecca a comfortable home at a reasonable price, only \$300/month with utilities included. In exchange for this reduced rent, which Anna uses to pay the utility bills. Rebecca provides Anna with companionship, help with errands, occasional trips to the doctor, household maintenance, pet care and shared meals. In addition, both women love films so they watch at least one movie together each week.
